Caregiver Registry Opt-Out Form



What's this Registry all about and why am I being asked to provide this information?

SB 1556 (Oregon 2022) requires that the Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS) establish and maintain an online home or community-based services caregiver registry accessible to the public.

For the purpose of this registry:

“Employer” includes the Oregon Home Care Commission, any in-home care agency that hires, enters into an arrangement with or contracts with a caregiver, Assisted Living Facilities and Residential Care Facilities that are licensed by the Office of Aging and People older adults and people with physical disabilities. It does not include facilities licensed by Office of Developmental Disabilities or the Oregon Health Authority.

“Caregiver” includes a home care worker, and an individual providing in-home care services as an employee of or under an arrangement or contract with an in-home care agency, a caregiver at a licensed Assisted Living Facility and a caregiver at a licensed Residential Care Facility. It does not include employees of adult foster homes or nursing facilities.

The creation of this registry will provide access for the public to search for a caregiver providing services within their local area/region. Employers are required to submit accurate information about their caregivers to ensure that the public has complete and accurate information. Caregivers are allowed by law to decline to participate on the Registry by completing and returning this Opt-Out Form to their employer or to ODHS.
